**ORDER**

In light of the defendant’s Notice, ECF No. 23, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the Defendant’s Motion Consent to Continue Status Conference and Request for Trial Date, ECF No. 20, is **GRANTED**.<sup>1</sup> It is further

**ORDERED** that the time from January 18, 2024, to February 21, 2024, is excluded under the Speedy Trial Act, in light of the postponement of the status conference in an unrelated Georgia state court case in which the defendant’s daughter is the victim and the resulting need for additional time to determine the status of that case.

<sup>1</sup> On January 17, 2024, the Court granted in part, denied in part, and held in abeyance in part the defendant’s motion. See Order at 1 (Jan. 17, 2024), ECF No. 22. The motion was granted to the extent that it sought a continuance of the status hearing that was previously scheduled for January 18, 2024. See *id.* The motion was denied to the extent it requested that the trial of this case be scheduled in 2025. See *id.* And, the motion was held in abeyance in all other respects, pending the filing of a notice signed by the defendant regarding the Speedy Trial Act. See *id.* This Order grants the portion of the motion that the Court previously held in abeyance.
