MOTION TO MODIFY CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

Steven Hanna, by and through counsel, respectfully moves this Court to modify his conditions of release for the following reasons:

- 1) On July 27, 2023, Mr. Hanna was released under conditions laid out in the Order Setting Conditions of Release. ECF No. 9.
- 2) One of the conditions requires Mr. Hanna to submit to drug testing, which “may include urine testing, the wearing of a sweat patch, a remote alcohol testing system, and/or any form of prohibited substance screening or testing.” ECF No. 9 at 2, ¶ 7(n).
- 3) Mr. Hanna does not oppose drug testing, but requests that the Pretrial Office utilize another form of testing based on his medical condition, which is described in the Attachments (to be filed under seal).

For all of the above reasons, Mr. Hanna requests that his release conditions be modified to utilize another form of substance abuse testing.
